Your presentation will be to re-present the research paper that you have already presented on. [*For groups*: please make sure this is a paper that *all* members of your group are familiar with.]

First ideas

Presentation aim

As before, the aim is to introduce the main points of your chosen research. However, think how to motivate the research e.g., with a beginning that connects to the real world (rather than theory). This is a good practice for when you have to introduce your own research or project. Think how to present drawing on ideas for using PPT that we have covered in the last parts of the course.

Who is the target audience?

The audience are scholars but without specific knowledge of the topic (area) that you are talking about. They are looking forward to hearing from the clever and energetic graduate students (you) in front of them!
